## Important information for healthcare professionals

This patient is being treated with ZYTORVI, which can cause immune-mediated adverse reactions that may appear any time during treatment or even after treatment. Assess patients for signs and symptoms of immune-mediated adverse reactions. Early diagnosis and appropriate management are essential to minimise any consequences of immune-mediated adverse reactions.

In cases of suspected immune-mediated adverse reactions, initiate appropriate workup to exclude alternative etiologies, including infection. Institute medical management promptly, including specialty consultation as appropriate. Based on the severity of the adverse reaction, withhold or permanently discontinue ZYTORVI and consider administration of corticosteroid therapy. Specific guidelines for managing immune-mediated adverse reactions are available in the Product Information for ZYTORVI.

Consultation with an oncologist or other medical specialist may be helpful for the management of organ-specific immune-mediated adverse reactions.

Important information for patients prescribed ZYTORVI

ZYTORVI may cause some serious side effects which can sometimes become life-threatening. You may experience more than one side effect at the same time. These may happen any time during treatment or even after your treatment has ended.

Contact your treating care team right away if you develop any side effects, or if they get worse. Early treatment of side effects may stop them becoming more serious.

**X DO NOT MANAGE SIDE EFFECTS YOURSELF**

This card does not take the place of speaking to your treating care team. They are there to help you – don't hesitate to contact them anytime.

- Do not attempt to diagnose or treat side effects yourself.
- Do not stop your treatment with ZYTORVI unless you have discussed this with your doctor.
- **Take this card with you at all times**, especially when you travel, whenever you go to the emergency room, or when you must see another health care provider.
- Be sure to notify any healthcare professional you see that you are being treated with ZYTORVI and show them this card.

Side effects

Call or see your treating care team right away, or go at your nearest hospital if you notice any of the below side effects.

LUNG PROBLEMS

- Cough
- Shortness of breath
- Chest pain

INTESTINAL PROBLEMS

- Loose stools or more frequent bowel movements than usual
- Stools that are black, tarry, sticky, or have blood or mucus
- Severe stomach-area (abdomen) pain or tenderness

LIVER PROBLEMS

- Yellowing of skin or the whites of your eyes
- Dark urine (tea colored)
- Severe nausea or vomiting
- Bleeding or bruising more easily than normal

HORMONE GLAND PROBLEMS

- Rapid heartbeat
- Weight gain or weight loss
- Increased sweating
- Hair loss
- Feeling cold
- Constipation
- Deeper voice
- Severe tiredness, dizziness or fainting
- Headaches that will not go away or unusual headache

KIDNEY PROBLEMS

- Changes in the amount of urine
- Changes in the colour of urine

SKIN PROBLEMS

- Rash
- Itching
- Skin blistering, peeling or sores
- Ulcers in mouth or in lining of nose, throat, or genital area.

HEART PROBLEMS

- Shortness of breath
- Irregular heartbeat
- Feeling tired
- Chest pain

ZYTORVI may cause other side effects that are not listed here.
